Subject : Operational and Maintenance of supply chain of essential commodities / services.

This is in continuation of letter No. SS/ACSH/2020/269 dated 27.03.2020 (copy enclosed) on the subject vide which you were requested to implement the Ministry of Home Affairs guidelines for maintenance of supply chain of essential services. You were also requested that workers and vehicles engaged in essential services must be allowed free movement during lockdown/curfew.

2. This issue was also discussed today i.e. 28.03.2020 during Video Conference chaired by Chief Secretary Punjab. After detailed discussions it has been decided as follows :

- i. All establishments engaged in the supply chain of essential commodities/services including manufacturers, transporters, warehouses, wholesalers/agents, retailers, carrying and forwarding agents, services delivery boys etc. must be provided full permission for conducting their activities at all times. This is necessary to ensure the required supply of essential commodities in the State.
- ii. Accordingly you are directed to immediately convene meetings of the Heads/Employers of all such establishments in your district and provide them the required number of permits/passes. For this purpose the District Food & Civil Supplies Controller, GM DIC, Drug Controller/Inspectors, Secretary RTA and other concerned officers may be directed to identify the establishments/employers and provide the required minimum number of permits/passes within one day.
