Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh vide Letter No. RCS/Mkg/spl-1 dated 30-03-2020 has written that GOI has allowed the movement of fertilizers to facilitate its supply for the next crop. In the State of Punjab, nearly 6 Lakh MTs of Urea and 54000 MTs of DAP is required to be supplied through the network of the cooperative societies. So far only 25% of the above quantity of fertilizers has been stored in cooperative societies. Hence the incoming rakes of the fertilizer have to be handled for loading, unloading and onward transportation to the concerned Societies without compromising the norms of social distancing.

In pursuance of the above-said letter of Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh, the following committee is allowed to be constituted in District Fazilka:-

1. Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Fazilka Chairman.
2. District Manager, Markfed, Fazilka – (In case of Markfed rakes).
3. District Manager, IFFCO, Fazilka – Convener (In case of IFFCO rakes)
4. Agriculture Officer concerned – Member follow strictly the protocol of social distancing and sanitation using masks, soap and sanitizer frequently.
5. This order shall Block Development and Panchayat Officer (BDPO) of concerned area- Member

The BDPO concerned will enable to rope in the labor under MGNREGA for this purpose. BDPOs are directed to coordinate with concerned Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies to take the demand for supply of MNREGA workers. BDPOs shall ensure that the MGNREGA workers become operational with immediate effect.

Prepositioning of the fertilizers in the (Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies) PACS for the forthcoming season – arrangements thereof

As we are passing through a tough time of the pandemic of Covid-19, due to which the Govt has declared complete lockdown upto 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2020. But now, the Govt has allowed the movement of fertilizers to facilitate its supply for the next crop.


In the state of Punjab nearly 8 lakh MTs of Urea and 54000 MTs of DAP is required to be supplied through the network of the cooperative societies. So far only 25% of the above quantity of fertilizers has been stored in the cooperative societies. The importance of prepositioning of fertilizers in the societies prior to the onset of season need be overemphasized. Hence, the incoming rakes of the fertilizer have to be handled for loading, unloading and onward transportation to the concerned cooperative societies without compromising the norms of social distancing.

For this purpose, a committee of the following officers is hereby constituted in all the districts of the State so that timely positioning of fertilizers could be done:-

- i) Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies of the concerned district - Chairman
- ii) District Manager, Markfed of the concerned District – Convener (in case of Markfed rakes)
- iii) District Manager, IFFCO of the concerned area – Convener (in case of IFFCO rakes)
- iv) Agriculture Officer of the concerned circle – Member
- v) Block Development & Panchayat Officer (BDPO) of the concerned area – Member

The BDPO has been put as a member of the committee so as to enable them to rope in the labour under MNREGA for this purpose.

You are requested to allow the above committee in all the districts of the State to function for the smooth advance stocking of fertilizer. It is also requested to direct the concerned BDPOs to coordinate with the concerned Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies to take the demand for supply of MNREGA workers.
